



Referee Assignments

CUFC home games are to be officiated by qualified referees according to the age group of the game and the qualification level of referee.

At least one week prior to the scheduled games, the CUFC Referee Coordinator will send out the home game schedule for the following two week period. All qualified and listed CUFC referees **MUST** confirm their acceptance of a game(s) by e-mail as soon as possible.

Referees **MUST** confirm that they will officiate a game by e-mailing the CUFC Referee Coordinator at referee@chestermereunited.com.

The Coordinator will confirm the game assignment by return e-mail.

Cancellation

CUFC will attempt to give as much notice to referees as possible if their assigned game is cancelled or rescheduled. This information will be communicated by e-mail to the referees concerned.

Rainout cancellations due to inclement weather which force field closures are updated on the CUFC website by 4pm weekdays and 2 hours prior to the game kick off time at weekends. www.chestermereunited.com. Referees are responsible for checking the CUFC website for cancelled games due to inclement weather.

Referees are able to request cancellation or substitution of their game assignment **up to 72 hrs** prior to the game kick-off. CUFC will find a replacement official for the game up to this deadline.

Within 72 hrs of the game kick-off time, referees are responsible for finding a suitable replacement official for the game. Any replacement official **MUST** be approved by the CUFC Referee Coordinator and the replacement referee **MUST** have the appropriate level of certification to officiate age group of game.

A referee contact list will be available from the CUFC Referee Coordinator.

*All referees **MUST** agree to their contact information being shared between the referee group.*
